About the first of April all of the insulators on the feed wires between Dalles and Monmouth and Independence will be removed to make room INDEPENDENCE, ORE For a new and be ter type, which has been especially evolved by electrical workers for that purpose. In order to make the transition with LIVELY and safety to the linemen employed in the work, it will be necessary to shut down the plant in this ci y for a period of possibly five hours each day during about three days. In order to inconvenience the patrons of the biht and power system as little as possible the shut-down will occur when there is the least demand for the service. Due n tice will be given by the company to all concerned by private letter and otherwise.

Upon complet on of the change of insulators, the new equipment at the power plant will be put into commission for the first time. For a number of months past the company has been making alterations and adding new machinery of the latest design, all of which has reached a total cost of something like \$30,000. Besides installing an immense watertube ho'ler, enlarging the huge storage bin, and putting in an automatic fuel feed, a monster Corliss engine of 400 horsepower has been placed in position and will soon be ready for use in connection with the present engine, or separately, as the oc casion may require.
