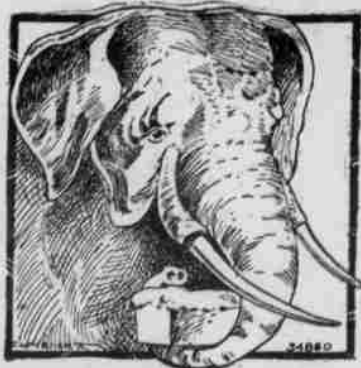
The board of school directors held a meeting Tuesday evening, but the result has not yet been given out for publication.
