RARE SPORT AT GREENWOOD

Robert Lowe, one of the best known sportsmen of Polk county, and the proud owner of a fine brace of black and tan fox hounds, purchased a coyote from a trapper near Dallas two weeks ago. Bob took good care of the animal until its crippled foot healed, it being injured by the trap when Bob advertised a chase, which took place at Greenwood last Sunday.

A big delegation of sports came over from Salem on the 9:15 motor, having with them eight fine fox hounds all of which entered the chase. Roy Martin entered his famous pair of spotted hounds, in all 14 dogs were to go after the wiley coyote. Last but not least was old Ruler, an old prized long eared fox hound owned by L. G. Arelhart.

The plan was to give the coyote 30 minutes start of the dogs. A barrel of money was weighted by the owners of the dogs that the coyote would be captured within one hour's time. Some argued that so many good dogs would not catch the wiley coyote in a camp short of fifteen hours if at all. Well the coyote was let out of his cage at 3:30 a. m., and let me say right here the owners of the dogs had their hand full to hold their respective trailers. The dogs would leap to their chain's end and drag the boys after them for several rods and then set on their haunches and bellow and howl and sit at once old Ruler parted his chain and there was nothing left for the boys to do but let all of the dogs go which they did precisely two and one half minutes after the coyote had left the trap and the real sport was on. Old Ruler's deep mellow voice could be heard above all the others so they took down the Rickrell through the timber and dense underbrush. One hour passed and the dogs were still on the trail and excitement was running high; two hours and still the wiley old coyote was leading that fleet bunch. They now seem to be running in a circle. Three hours pass and find the coyote across the creek from whence it started. 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 hours pass and the gallant hounds have not taken in the fox.

Just as the dogs were about to give up the chase, a shot was fired and the dogs returned but two. Mr. Lowe's two famous hounds stayed in the race all night and until 3:30 p. m. the next day and Mr. Lowe went after them and had a hard time calling them off the trail and the cunning old coyote had led the two hounds away to the north and over the Eola range of mountains toward the Spring Valley country where sheep are plentiful like wise chickens and ducks, where the victor of the great race can once more fast and roam the wilds in peace.

Thus ends the first coyote chase of the Greenwood country.

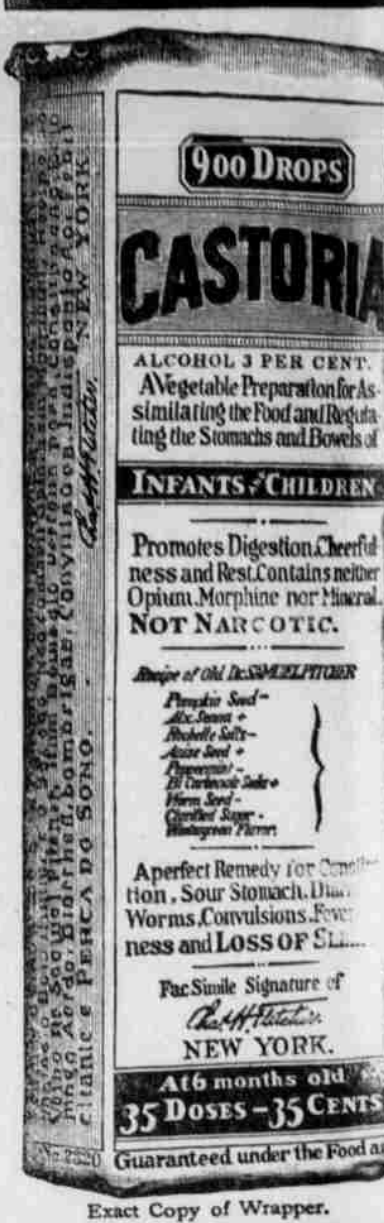
