### BIG DEMAND AT BIG PRICES RASPBERRIES AND LOGAN-BERRIES.

Raspberries—There will be an extensive acreage planted to strawberries this season and when they come into bearing, which will be in 1920, there will be a generous supply. It might be of general interest to learn that 50% of all the jellies, jams and preserves manufactured throughout the country are from strawberries; 33% from raspberries and the balance of 17% from Loganberries, Gooseberries, Currants and kindred berries. What we desire to impress upon you is the importance and advisability of greatly increasing the production of Raspberries and Loganberries. In Oregon there are very few raspberries grown. In fact, the quantity is so small as to be hardly considered, and it will be many, many years before there will be sufficient supply to meet the requirements of the Oregon manufacturers. Loganberries—There is a constantly increasing demand for loganberries. These are finding an enlarged market, but there are not enough berries to go around. The market price today is \$140.00 per ton for Loganberries in bearing, which is the highest
