OREGON JOINS NATION IN GOOD POTATO QUEST

Action Grows Out of Farmers' Need for Good Seed, Says G. R. Hyslop, in Charge.

Oregon has entered into a co-operative agreement with the United States department of agriculture to determine, grow and distribute for seed purposes the best varieties of potatoes under Oregon conditions. The work will be conducted through the experiment station of the agricultural college, with G. R. Hyslop, professor of farm crops in charge.

"This joint action has grown out of the need felt by farmers throughout the state for good seed potatoes free of disease," said Professor Hyslop. "The co-operative potato experiment is to make available for growers good seed potatoes."

Different varieties will be grown in comparative tests to determine which produce the greatest yield free of disease and good quality. Cultural work will be done to determine the best methods of cultivation, size time to plant, and manner of planting.

The station will not go into the seed producing business, Professor Hyslop explains, but aims to give farmers who desire it a start in the production of good seed potatoes, which will increase their yields and financial returns.
