STUDENT FARM JOURNAL TO TELL STORY OF SILO

Oregon Countryman Will Feature Progress and Use of Silage Feeding in July Number.

Erection of 1200 new silos in Oregon this season has prompted the Oregon Countryman, published by the students of Agricultural College to tell in the July issue the story of the progress in silo construction and use of silage in this state.

"Silage is fed by many successful dairymen wherever green pasture fails for any part of the year," says C. J. McIntosh of the department of industrial journalism, who will edit the summer vacation numbers. "Silos are called pastures under cover, available at all times and in any amounts needed.

"Long regarded as a winter and dairy spring feed, silage is now used to prolong the summer succulent season. Such crops as vetch and oats, put down with plenty of water, are fed through fall as needed. Later, corn and other standard silages are fed through the winter and early spring till grass comes. Spring is the best milk season, but the silo has brought near-spring to thousands of Oregon dairy cows.

"Silage is also largely used as beef cattle and sheep feeds in Oregon. Some of the state's most successful cattle and sheep men have become the biggest silo boosters, and the story of their use of silage will be told in the Oregon Countryman by E. L. Potter, professor of animal husbandry, for the benefit of other livestockmen and farmers.
