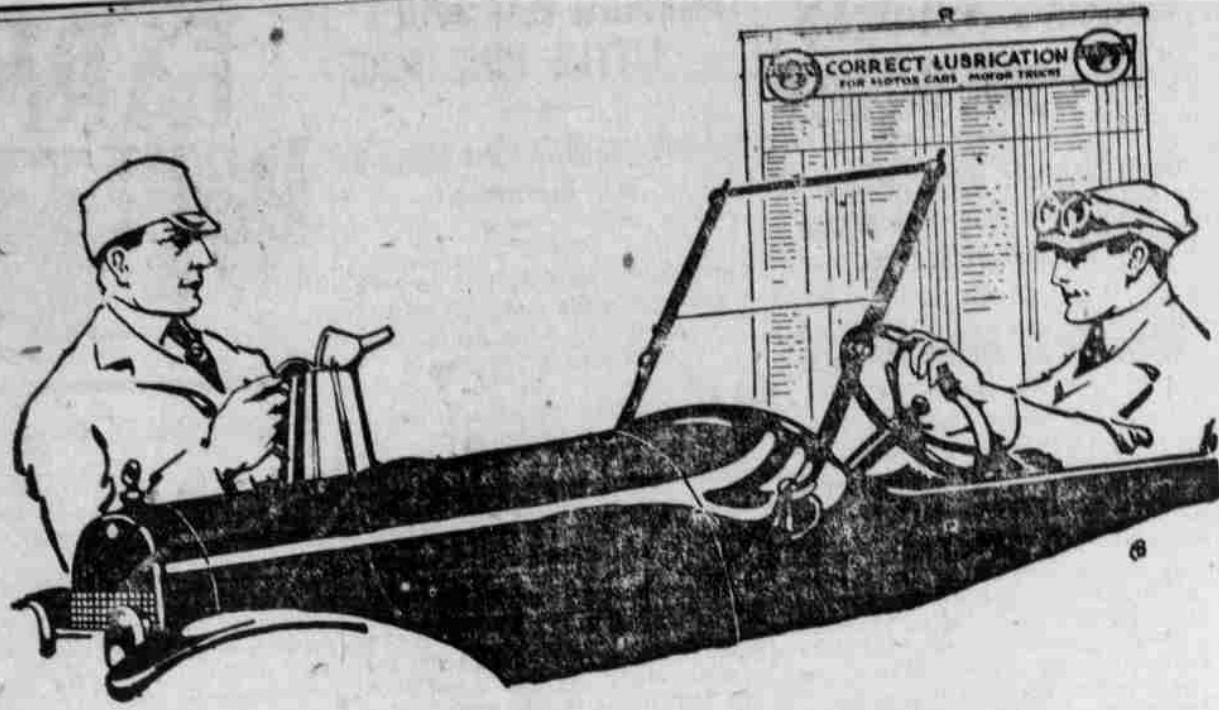
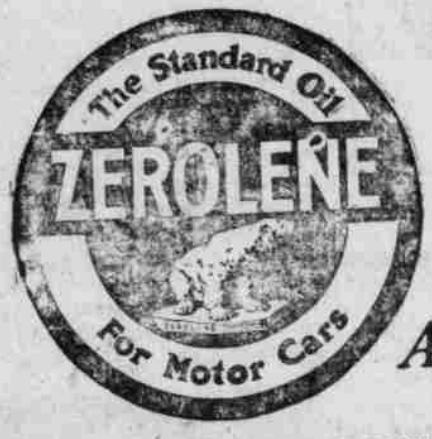

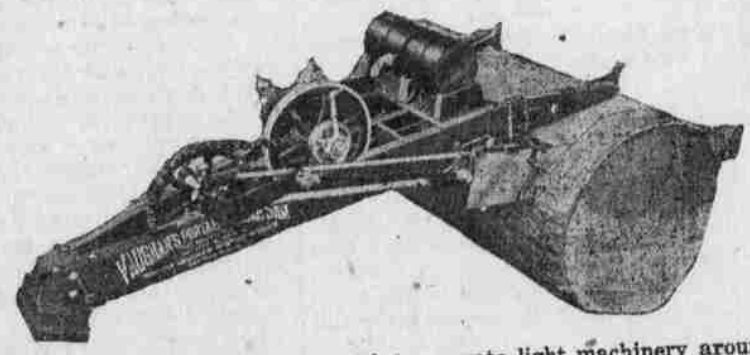

DRY PROVINCES MAY HAVE THEIR LIQUOR

The senate of Canada has reaffirmed its position again on the prohibition question. When the government measure came up recently, continuing the national prohibition measure for one year after the war, the senate cut out the one year provision, thus killing the measure with the signing of peace. Sir. James Lougeed, government leader in the senate, this week moved an amendment to restore the clause, but was voted down. The national prohibition measure did not in itself enact prohibition, but made it illegal to manufacture or import liquor into a dry province from a wet one, the enactment of prohibition itself being left to the provinces. It will thus be permissible for the other provinces to import wine and beer from Quebec, where their sale is legal.
