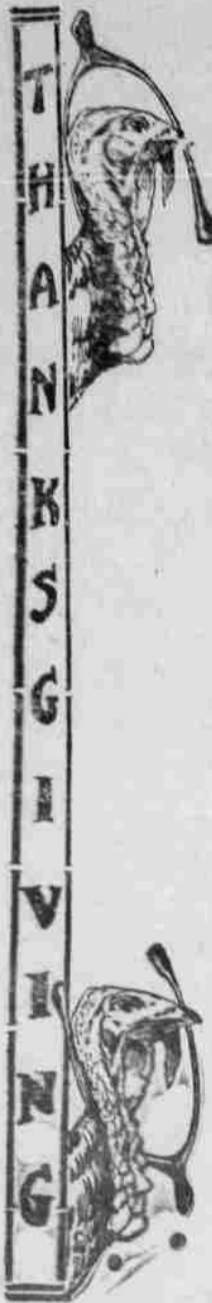

TO CO-OPERATE IN STUDY OF DESTRUCTIVE PESTS

Investigational Work is Being Carried on by College and United States Bureau of Entomology.

A co-operative arrangement for investigational work, between the bureau of entomology at Washington, D. C., and the department of entomology at the Oregon Agricultural College has been arranged. Investigational work is under way at two points in Oregon. The federal station was organized in 1914 at Forest Grove. L. P. Rockwood is working the colling moth control at the Medford station established in 1916.

Since a recent visit in Oregon by Dr. W. R. Walton, chief of the division of cereal and forage insects of the bureau of entomology at Washington, D. C., the station has been working with the college department of which Prof. A. L. Lovett is in active charge. The co-operative bureau has been formed through the co-operation of federal and state entomologists.

An investigation is being carried on with wire worms and false wire worms affecting wheat in eastern Oregon and Washington. Due to these insects thousands of acres of wheat destroyed each year. These investigations are expected to be of great value wheat interests, but the solution will take several years. The temporary field station is at Lind, Washington. The federal station has been doing investigational work with the insect pest of cereal and forage crops and a report has been practically completed after three years of work.

"Controlling the Clover Flower Midge in the Pacific Northwest, United States Department of Agricultural Bulletin 642 by Mr. Rockwood has published as a result of the investigations by the bureau. The clover root borer is considered as destructively a pest at the clover midges. Work with the army worm and the cut worm is now being conducted in western Oregon with a view to controlling serious outbreaks when they occur.

Doctor Walton considered the possibility of having a man stationed at Baker for the purpose of studying the wheat insects.
