Cement stones or blocks are also used, but to no great extent. The common material is red brick, made in a great number of larger and smaller brick works. Normally, the more important works produced about 40,000,000 bricks annually. At present the supply is about exhausted.

SMART FABRIC HAT

Headgear and Matching Scarf of Fashionable Material.

Velvet, Velveteen, Velours, Duvelyn, Trimmed in Appliqued or Embroidered Motifs, to Suit.

The sketch shows a smart hat and matching scarf to be made of velvet, velveteen, velours, duvelyn or other fashionable material, trimmed in appliqued or embroidered motifs. Such a set may be worn with a plain suit or frock with excellent effect, and for the most severe weather the wool fabric scarf will be just as comfortable and often smarter than fur.

Hat and scarf may easily be made at home and the cost need be only moderate. Wool fabrics, such as duvelyn or very fine soft velours are fully as smart and really much newer than velvet for making these softly draped hats and, as little trimming is required, they are really quite inexpensive, or may be if fashioned at home.

The draped hat, like the draped frock, is usually welcomed by the amateur. Tailored frocks or suits require expert workmanship, while the draped ones offer no perplexing problem to the home dressmaker. The same rule applies to the millinery field. Many fabric hats are elaborately braided in silk, chenille or wool, and a good deal of applique work is used. Otherwise they are practically without trimming.

Fur hats are much in evidence and it is interesting to note that ponyskin is apparently a favorite. It is shown in both brown and black, the former leading. One exceptionally smart model, recently seen, had a crown of

brown pony and wide, slightly rolled brim of gold lace. The hat, of course, was for dressy afternoon or evening wear.

Ponyskins coats are popular again this winter, and the woman who bought one when this pelt first came into favor several years ago is fortunate if she kept it. The pelts now being used are softer and lighter in weight than those of several seasons ago, but the old coat is by no means ready for the discard because of this slight disadvantage.

FUR USED ON FULL TRAINS

Sable, Skunk, Kolinsky, Sealiskin, Squirrel, Chinchilla and Fox. Among Favored Pelts.

Fur is used with wonderfully lovely effect on trains of the thinnest tulle or metallic net, swung from the shoulders of evening gowns, barbaric in the splendor of their loveliness.

Brocades that glitter with gold and silver, woven with colors that reflect the loveliness of the metals, develop the season's most gorgeous evening toilettes.

Sable, skunk, kolinsky, sealiskin, squirrel, chinchilla and fox—white or black—are used to trim these trains, whose sheerness emphasizes the loveliness of the fur.

An evening gown of yellow and gold brocade is draped about the figure in lines that emulate the princess gowns of other years. The front shows only the brocade, held by shoulder straps of topaz beads strung with jet and gold. A beautiful bead ornament holds the long, square train of yellow tulle, weighted with a broad band of sable whose brown tones harmonize beautifully with the yellow and gold fabrics of the gown.

Silver or gold slippers are worn with these gowns, together with stockings of pale gold or gray.

The New Week-End Frocks.

The sport dress has faded into the past, and the week-end dress has come forward to take its place. The week-end dress must be one that is practical for all purposes and of material that is substantial, in good color, suitable for evening, sports or street. This week-end dress is made to do away with the necessity for carrying much baggage when one goes off for the week-end. A broad collar on a suit shown was entirely of French plaid, which added considerably to the richness of the suit. Pin tucked and embroidered tricolettes are shown in suits for Southern resort wear.
