The Work Goes On.

The work of getting out rock at the Jim Prather quarry above Buena Vista for the revetment near Independence goes merrily on.

A few days ago there was considerable uneasiness among local laborers employed on the job, as a report was circulated that the supply of rock was nearly exhausted. This rumor proved groundless, however, when examination of the quarry was made by Charles K. Spaulding of Newberg, last week. This gentleman declared there was rock of excellent quality in abundance and the work is going on with renewed vigor.

J. C. Smith is the foreman in charge and the steamer Eugene hauls the rock to the revetment. About a dozen men are employed on the works and times are lively in the village because of the money thus placed in circulation.
