The withers must practically swear to the same state ments as the claimant maker, Perjury is easy for one, but when threa persons have easy. Formerly the government did not require claimant to state where he obtained his timber claim, but in order t head off the bribing of poor claim ants of land by wealthy speculator in timber tracts, the governmen made the conditions harder.
