OME PORTLAND
FAIR STATISTICS

The total number of admissions to the Lewis and Clark fair from June 1 to October 14 inclusive was 2,545,539, which is a million more than a conservative estimate made by the fair officials before the fair opened. Of the total number entering the gates 1,045,507 went in on passes, 99 per cent of these were entered on the grounds and members of the fair. The four largest days were as follows: Portland day, 87,149; closing day, 66,900; Fourth of July, 53,738; and closing day, 39,656. Nearly a 40 per cent dividend to the exhibitors will be declared. The fair is said to have been the most successful financially of any held in the United States except the Trans-Mississippi exposition at St. Louis.

ARMITAGE
KILLS MRS.
STOOPS

Press dispatches from Marshfield, Coos county, tell of a double tragedy there yesterday afternoon in which the principals were former Lane county people.

J. A. (Aurelius) Armitage entered the home of J. O. Stoops, shot and killed Mrs. Stoops and then shot himself dead. It seems that Armitage had been infatuated with Mrs. Stoops for a long time past. He had before threatened her life and she was very much afraid of him. He entered the house by crawling through a window. He started upstairs, where Mrs. Stoops was. She ordered him to stop, but he continued up the steps. Mrs. Stoops then fired at him with a revolver, inflicting a slight wound on Armitage's scalp. Armitage, who was armed with a rifle and a pistol, dropped the rifle and with the pistol shot Mrs. Stoops through the heart. She died instantly. The murderer then ran to his own lodgings, where he killed himself by blowing out his brains.

The Stoops family left here about three years ago for Marshfield. Armitage left his family to go with them. It is said that he and the Stoops woman had been on intimate terms for several years.

Armitage leaves a most estimable family, residing on a farm in the High Banks neighborhood, above Springfield. Ever since he left them his wife and two sons have conducted the farm. One of his daughters, Miss Estelle, is teacher in the Eugene public schools. The family has the highest respect of all who know them, and the character of each member is spotless. Armitage was a member of Helmet Lodge, Knights of Pythias, of Eugene.

The Stoops family formerly lived near the Armitage farm. Mrs. Stoops was a member of the Moore family, well known about the city and county. She leaves, besides a husband, five children.

LATER REPORTS.

Later dispatches state that Mrs. Stoops shot Armitage through the head first, the ball entering above the left eye. Just then he fired, the ball taking effect in her heart.

The following letters were found on Armitage's table:

"To the Coroner: Please have my body fixed in proper shape and phone to my brother, F. L. Armitage, at Eugene, Or.

"J. A. ARMITAGE."

"To the Coast Mail: I will make a statement in regard to this affair. I am not doing this because I fear the outcome of a trial, but I think it would be more of a disgrace for me to appear in court with such people than to commit this deed. In regard to her complaint, it is absolutely false. I never presented a gun, nor threatened her life. She made the remark: 'You want to threaten my life.' I said I did not want to do any such a thing, and now they are not satisfied when I am attending to my own business, but they are tormenting me in every way because they think they have the advantage of me for a few months. Yours truly,

"J. A. ARMITAGE."

"P. S.—She told me one time when we lived in South Marshfield that if she ever caught me with another woman she would kill me sure."

ACCOUNT OF TRAGEDY.

Stoops was away from home, and Mrs. Stoops, with her young children, locked herself in the house, fearing that Armitage would force himself upon her.

Armitage sat in his window all day in the house he had rented near the Stoops home so as to be near the object of his love, smoking with a rifle by his side. The woman not coming outside the house, he took his rifle and went to her door. When Armitage tried to force it in Mrs. Stoops fired at him through the door, but the ball missed its mark. He then entered the house through a window and started upstairs. She fired at him as he came up the stairs, the ball entering his head just above the left eye. He also fired, the ball taking effect in her heart.

Armitage crawled through the window and went into his own house, where he died soon afterwards. According to a statement made by Armitage some time previous, the intimacy between Mrs. Stoops and himself began while Stoops and his family were living on Armitage's ranch near Eugene. He was very much in love with the woman and claimed his love was reciprocated.

SIUSLAW
SCHOONER
WRECKED

A press dispatch from Maistfield says: The lumber-laden schooner Sacramento, which left Siuslaw Saturday, bound for San Francisco, went ashore about four miles north of the entrance to Coos Bay at 10 o'clock Sunday morning. The crew were rescued with difficulty by the life-saving service. The vessel is fast going to pieces and with its cargo will be a total loss. After leaving Siuslaw the Sacramento encountered a heavy southwest gale, and with a strong westerly swell was driven on the beach.

No estimates are obtainable as to the value of the vessel and cargo. The Sacramento was a scows-chooner of 121 tons owned by Beadle Bros., of San Francisco, and was in the lumber trade between the lower Oregon coast and California.

Off twelve acres of river bottom land two miles above Springfield he picked 28,008 pounds, making 141 bales, an average of 2333 pounds to the acre. This does not represent the actual yield per acre, however, as several hundred hills, making close to an acre, failed to come last year and were replanted this spring, making probably not over a third of an acre.
