What is the Reason?

WANTED—To buy a lumber proposition on rail and water, mills and timber. Nothing wanted on Southern Pacific. Address "315," care the Timberman.

The above advertisement appeared in the March issue of the Timberman published at Portland. Much comment is indulged in upon the fact that the buyer would not purchase lands on the Southern Pacific system.

If the reason for this is caused by higher freight rates or shortage of cars, it should be remedied immediately. There must be some good reason for such an advertisement.

The Walla Walla Union facetiously remarks that "there is likely to be a scandal if winter continues to linger much longer in the lap of spring."

Pendleton will at once have ten blocks of bituminous pavement laid on her principal business streets. Eugene is as big as Pendleton. When will we follow suit?

In 1905 lumber laden sail vessels to the number of 324, and 271 steam vessels sailed from Gray's Harbor, Washington, an average of eleven cargoes of lumber a week.

The Chicago letter in the Portland Timberman of March 2, tells how rough lumber that ten years ago was not very rapid sale at \$8 to \$10 a thousand feet now brings \$18 to \$19, with good demand.

The Portland civil service commission has placed a limit on the age at which laborers on the city work may first be employed. Fifty years is the limit.

The leaps and bounds of the Pacific coast lumber business is fully shown by comparative statements of shipments, foreign, coastwise and rail for 1900 and 1905. In 1900 it totalled 284,000,000 feet. Five years later, 1905, it had grown fourfold to 3,750,000,000 feet.

Corvallis has always been a town of sensations. The latest is a revival meeting at which the press correspondents say, "strong men weep like children." We venture the assertion that after the revival is over most if not all of these "strong" men will be as sin-hardened as ever.

Secretary of State Root says Hamilton is a "bar." That insurance investigation is stirring things up near headquarters. The secretary probably felt somewhat kinder to Mr. Hamilton about the time he handed over that \$75,000 of New York Life Insurance Company funds for the presidential campaign. Hamilton shows the voucher for the contribution.

The extent of the Northern lumber trade with Southern California, Nevada, Utah, Arizona, New Mexico and Mexico, is shown by a letter to the Tacoma Lumberman from its Los Angeles correspondent, under date March 3. There were then thirty-nine cargoes unloading at its single port, with twenty-six scheduled on the way down. The railroads distribute it. Common 12-inch fir boards bring \$30 dollars a thousand at Los Angeles.

At the graduation of forty-five students from the University of Chicago, Tuesday, a speaker declared the university was being operated at a loss of \$2,500,000 a year. Yet no complaint is heard from its owner. One cannot but think of the immense wealth gathered together in one hand that permits such an expenditure. Such object lessons make socialists. Any way why should our law permit the taking of fortunes from the people for the upbuilding of individuals? How can it all be corrected—it will be corrected.
