JUNCTION MAN LEAVES FOR PARTS UNKNOWN

Junction City, Oct. 9.—J. B. McFarland, who has conducted a blacksmith shop and carried a large line of farming implements at this place, has departed for parts unknown. He came here about eight years ago without any money, but being a good workman he had no trouble in renting the old John Blew blacksmith shop, and by attending closely to business he was soon on the road to prosperity.

In a little while he was able to buy the shop and enlarged it and added new machinery until he had one of the most complete workshops in the valley. The past year or two he has been drinking quite heavily, and his wife having left him, he became very reckless, and suddenly thinking she would try to secure part of his property he made arrangements to get together all the money he could to pre-vent her getting anything and has skipped the country.

McFarland has been selling all kinds of farming machinery at a very low price and sold during last harvest about \$1500 worth of binding twine, and as he had not paid anything to the wholesale houses for these goods, it will leave them in the "hole."

McFarland is known to have had close to \$4000 in cash a few days before he left. It is not known how much he owes his creditors. Attachments were filed on the buildings and tools today. McFarland's actions have been a great surprise to his many friends. It is reported that he has been seen at the Jamestown fair, and that he said he would never return to Oregon.
