## FORMAL TRANSFER OF EUGENE ELECTRIC RAILWAY LINE

EUGENE & EASTERN RAILWAY CO. DEEDS PROPERTY TO PORTLAND, EUGENE & EASTERN RAILWAY FOR \$505,400—NEW COMPANY AT COTTAGE GROVE

The Eugene street railway property was today formally transferred by the Eugene & Eastern Railway Company to the Portland, Eugene & Eastern Railway Company, the new concern, by the filing of the deed for record with the county clerk.

The deed calls for the transfer of the railway line that has been built, the franchise granted by the city of Eugene to the Willamette Valley Co. to construct the line, afterward conveyed to A. Welch and afterward to the E. & E., also the franchise granted by the city of Springfield, all right-of-way, easements, etc., for the proposed line from Eugene to Blue River; all ties, rails, tools, implements, rolling stock, cars and in fact everything in connection with the operation of the line in Eugene; also lots 6, 7, 8 and 9, block 4, in University addition to Eugene, and certain land in the Gross addition to Eugene. The consideration as given in the deed is \$505,400, and the instrument is signed by J. O. Storey, president, and E. W. Hall, secretary of the Eugene & Eastern Company.

New Company at Cottage Grove The Guard a few days ago mentioned the fact that the Willamette Valley Company's electric plant at Cottage Grove was transferred to A. Welch. Today a deed conveying the property from him to the Cottage Grove Electric Company, a new concern recently incorporated, was filed for record. The consideration given in the deed is \$50,000.

## ANOTHER WOMAN SHOPLIFTER IS CAUGHT AT ALBANY

MRS. DIXON IS FOUND STEALING WAIST AT CHAMBERS AND McCUNE'S STORE — ATTEMPTS SUICIDE BY TAKING MORPHINE

Detected in the act of concealing a valuable lady's waist under her cloak in Chambers & McCune's store at Albany, Mrs. Dixon, a woman of about 50 years of age who claims to reside in Halsey, this morning attempted to commit suicide by swallowing a dozen morphine tablets which she had in her possession, says yesterday's Herald. The woman swallowed three of the morphine tablets before she could be prevented.

Mrs. Dixon when seized by E. H. McCune who had watched her conceal the waist under her cloak, struggled desperately to escape, and screamed loudly. A boy of eight years who says his name is Roy Corken, a grandson, was with the woman when caught stealing the waist from the counter in the store, and attempted to defend his grandmother by snatching a pair of scissors from one of the lady clerks who was aiding Mr. McCune in holding the struggling woman and making vicious stabs at both Mr. McCune and the clerk. When an officer arrived a search was made of Mrs. Dixon's clothing with the result that over a dozen lace collars identified as taken from the counters in the store were found. While being searched the woman tried to commit suicide by swallowing the morphine tablets, but was prevented. A short time afterward, while in Justice Swan's office, the woman succeeded in swallowing three of the morphine tablets. She was in a very hysterical condition this afternoon and with the effects of the drug it was difficult to examine her and the examination will be held sometime this evening, or late this afternoon.

The prisoner had a suit case which was examined and found to contain numerous articles such as perfume, waists, silk remnants, spools of thread, and even a large quantity of Bologna sausage. Some of the articles were identified as having come from various stores in town. A bottle supposed to contain whiskey was also in the suit case. Where the woman procured her "dope" and the liquor is not positively known as yet, but Deputy District Attorney Gale S. Hill is investigating the affair. From indications the woman is addicted to the use of morphine, in her struggles to escape from Mr. McCune Mrs. Dixon's cloak was badly torn. She has been under suspicion for some weeks and for this reason Mr. McCune watched her when she came of shoplifting by women in the last ten days in this city.

A later report states the name of the woman arrested for shoplifting is Mrs. Vanderlip of Shedd, and not Mrs. Dixon, as she herself states.
