GUARDSMEN WILL FRAME A BETTER ARMORY BILL

Failure of the armory bill to receive popular endorsement at the polls June 1 has not discouraged the Oregon National Guard in its campaign for armories in the military stations outside of Portland. The view is taken by Guardsmen that the measure was defeated because of a lack of understanding of the needs and utilities of armories. The favorable vote was very large, especially in the cities, the cutting being done in the rural districts.

Heppner, Or., June 11.—Dan Doherty was convicted of murder in the second degree today for the slaying of Oscar Allen, when the latter refused to buy drinks for a crown in a Lexington saloon. The jury deliberated for more than 15 hours.

ONE INJUNCTION GRANTED, ANOTHER IS REFUSED

Dallas, June 12.—This morning an injunction was served on County Judge Cook, restraining him from issuing his proclamation declaring Polk county dry. The prosecutors are two saloonmen of Dallas, who declare in their complaint that the local option law is unconstitutional. The saloons of the county will probably not be allowed to run after July 1 if the case is not decided before then.
