FOREST SERVICE HAS 4 LAUNCHES ON THE COAST

A. E. Cohoon, supervisor of the Sitka Forest Reserve, has three gasoline launches in operation and another under construction for the convenience of the service. One launch is on the Umpqua, another on the Sitka, and a third on the Alsea river. The fourth launch is being built for Smith river, a branch of the Umpqua inlet, which is navigable for twelve miles.

All of these streams have a number of miles of navigable water, usually just as far as the tide reaches, on the main trunk and its branches. The Umpqua river of itself runs back nearly thirty miles, the Sitka up twenty, while the Alsea extends back into the interior perhaps fifteen.

The government has been put to considerable expense by not having launches at the service of the rangers. One time Mr. Cohoon had to wait a whole day to cross one of the streams. By the rules governing the boats, they can only be used for government purposes, not for pleasure or business. At any time when a traveler or settler can be aided when in trouble by the launches and the men or women in control, the instructions are that they shall be put at the service of the unfortunate.

In fact, this is one of the principles of the whole service, and the settlers frequently find themselves indebted to the rangers who look after the interests of the government.

Takew Ocean Ride

This week Wilbur J. Stillwell, a ranger who for a long time was a follower of the sea, took a launch from Florence to Alsea, where it was wanted. For some time Supervisor Cohoon wanted the craft at Alsea but no schooner happened to be entering both ports on the same trip, and he had about given up the idea of taking the craft over.

One day he happened to mention the matter to Stillwell, who volunteered to take the craft over on its own bottom. Cohoon objected, for the launch is only twenty feet long, considering such a project hazardous. The seaman insisted on doing it on his own responsibility, stating that there was no danger in particular. He went to Florence last week and carried out his plan, much to the astonishment of the sea-faring population of Florence.

FAMOUS RUSSIAN AUTHOR IS EIGHTY YEARS OLD

St. Petersburg, Aug. 28.—Notwithstanding the frowns of the government officials, the protests of the reactionary bureaucratic element and the prevalence of a cholera epidemic in the Tula province, where Count Leo Tolstol lives, all Russians belonging to the educated and progressive class are today joined in celebrating the eightieth birthday of the great "Apostle of Liberty." It is true, some of the features of the proposed celebration were reluctantly abandoned, but the greater part of the program was carried out with every evidence of genuine enthusiasm for the most popular character of Russia. The proposed pilgrimage of Tolstol's most ardent admirers to his home in Tula had to be abandoned as it was not considered safe to permit thousands to congregate in a district where several hundred persons have died from cholera during the past week. The pilgrims had intended to march to Tula on foot and live the "simple life" on the way, and upon reaching Tula to propose to form a big camp near Tolstol's home, to exemplify the Utopian theories of simplicity and close communion with nature, as advanced by the great "Torch Bearer."

The central committee in charge of the international celebration included among its members the artist and public man, not in Russia, and it had no difficulty in enlisting the support of many distinguished men in nearly every European country, the United States and some of the British colonies. The committee had started several important movements coincident with the celebration, and all of them proved to be successful. One of the plans is to raise enough money to purchase the copyright of Tolstol's books, so that cheap editions may be published with a view of popularizing the ideas and theories of Russia's grand old man. Another movement is directed toward the establishment of a Tolstol institute and museum in St. Petersburg.

Letters and telegrams of congratulation, addresses and birthday presents for the count were sent to him in large numbers from every part of the Russian empire and from many parts of the world. Many tokens of admiration and sympathy came from the United States, Germany, France and England. Judging from the general and enthusiastic manner in which Tolstol's birthday was celebrated throughout Russia today the count is at the height of his popularity. The fact that quite recently Count Tolstol has been "persona non grata" to the Russian government, even more than before, may have been a stimulating influence upon the sympathies of that large class of educated Russians belonging to the opposition. Tolstol represents, more than any man in Russia, the progressive and radical element. Nearly all his life he has been on the opposition side, defying and combatting the evil influences surrounding the throne, the bureaucratic clan and the reactionary faction of the nobility. His sympathies have ever been with the people, and his aim has ever been to lead them to freedom and happiness. Yet his radicalism was not of a violent nature, and never did he advocate the use of force or violence. The nihilists of Russia, the anarchistic element, found neither support nor sympathy with Tolstol.

Tolstol had a remarkable career. He was born of noble and wealthy parents at Vasnaya, Polyana, on August 28, 1828. His parents died while he was a child and he was left in charge of an aunt. He received the usual education of a Russian noble, first at home and afterward, in 1843-44 at the University of Kazan, where he entered the faculty of Eastern languages and literature. In 1844 he took up the study of law and was granted his degree and admitted to practice in 1848. In 1851 he accompanied his brother to the Caucasus and entered the army. It was during his residence in the Caucasus that he wrote his earliest novels. In 1853 he joined the Russian army of the Danube and fought against the Turks. In 1862 he married Miss Sophie Bhrs in Moscow, who has had the most remarkable influence upon his life, his religious and sociological views, and has many beliefs, saved him from financial ruin and from becoming a mental wreck. His first great novel, "Anna Karenina," was published in 1875 and made him famous. Although the income from his estate and from the copyright of his books would enable him to live in keeping with his rank, Count Tolstol has ever since his marriage lived the simple life of a peasant, denying himself all luxuries. His time is divided between his literary work and labor in the fields or at the cobbler's bench, where he makes shoes for himself, his family and his neighbors. His ethical, sociological and political teachings have produced a deep but persistent not merely in Russia but throughout the whole civilized world and the old man has thousands of ardent admirers all over the globe.
