

ONLY BANK SHARES TAXABLE UNDER LAW

Also Real Property — Their
Notes Are Not As-
sessable

Salem, Or., Oct. 22.—Holding that only shares of stock in the hands of stockholders and the real property of national banks are assessable under the rulings of the supreme court of the United States, the tax commis-

sioner, appliances, general assets, money, notes, stocks except shares in other banks, bonds and bills receivable, are held to be exempt from taxation by the statutes.

The commission concludes after citing many cases that the Oregon law for assessment of bank stocks, shares and banking capital for taxation, is entirely in harmony with the Federal law, permitting the real estate of the national banks and the shares of stocks in the hands of the shareholders to be assessed for taxation by authority of the state.

CITY POWER PLANT IS VERY NEAR COMPLETED

Has Been Immense Undertaking, But All Obstacles Are Overcome

After many vexatious delays, after slow and tedious work with opposition and lack of men, the big city power ditch at Waltherville, which will supply water to the two 1200-horsepower pelton turbines at the city's power plant, now stands practically complete. The big concrete head gates are finished, the immense ditch is dug, and the big wooden flume that runs to the plant and the forebay at the plant are within ten days of completion. The concrete foundations and piers for the electrical apparatus, and the concrete pits for the turbines are set, the sheet iron walls of the big building are being put up and the whole plant now shows its real appearance. The time when the McKenzie river will be harnessed to Eugene's water plant and to its street lighting system now hovers in sight.

The construction of the big ditch has been an immense undertaking.

hard at work. Standing water has also bothered the workmen. The ditch terminates about 700 feet or slightly more than two blocks above the power plant. Here the water will enter the flume. This is a wooden affair made of heavy timber and lined with water tight with dressed planking, and measures about 8 feet by 10. This terminates in what is called the forebay. This is in reality an immense wooden tank. It is built in the same manner as the flume and is about 70x80 feet and is 12 feet deep. This corresponds to the mill pond and from this lead the two steel pipes that drop 48 feet to the big pelton water wheels. Over this is the power plant itself. The building stands on concrete piles 24 feet above the ground. It is an oblong structure about 30x100, with a wing on one side about 30 feet square. Here will be placed the big electrical generators and transformers. The frame of this building is up and workmen are today placing the sheet iron. As soon as the roof is on the machinery will be installed. This is the matter of a few weeks. The only work that now prevents the turning of the water in the big ditch is the construction of the intake. The excavation on this is being done by A. C. Mathews and good progress is being made. It will be completed before high water will stop the work.

The construction of the ditch complete, and the cost of the machinery, it is thought, will total in the vicinity of \$200,000. Although there is considerable work yet to be done the

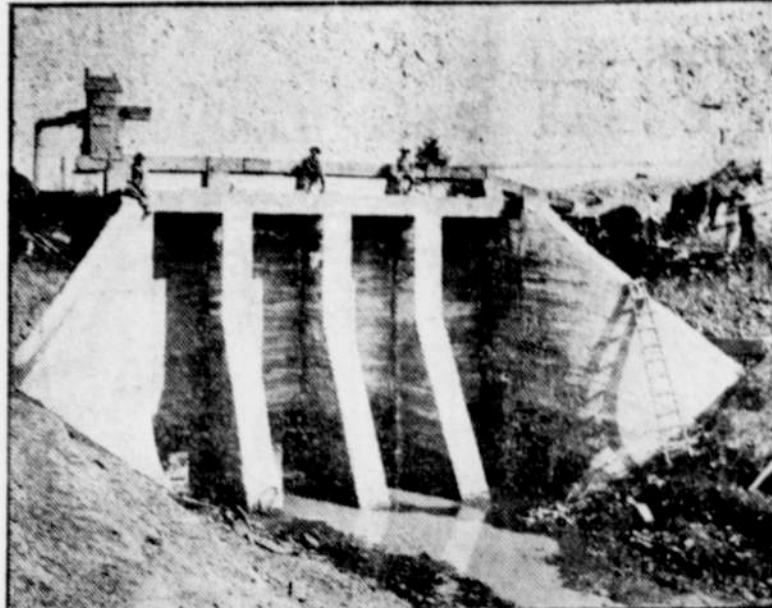
