Injunction Dissolved.

Tuesday's Albany Democrat: "Judge Burnett, of the Circuit Court, last evening handed in his decision in the wheat case of Moore, Ferguson & Co., against W. F. Crosby et al, dissolving the injunction restraining the removal of the wheat. The decision establishes the fact that the wheat did not belong to the defendant Crosby and the plaintiffs will have to take some other course in their claim against him. Upon securing the temporary injunction Moore, Ferguson & Co. gave bonds to the O. C. & E. for \$3000 and moved the wheat to San Francisco, further complicating the matter. H. C. Watson, and Blackburn, Somers & Duncan appeared for the plaintiff in the case, Weatherford & Wyatt for W. F. Crosby, and Geo. W. Wright, for the Albany Farmers Co. The decision probably settles the matter so far as this wheat is concerned."

Changed His Mind.
