THE PEOPLES PARTY "PUSH."

An Eastern Oregon exchange says the Willamette papers of last week contained resolutions unanimously adopted by the peoples party state central committee. The first was independent political action, and the last was what might have been expected, endorsement of the legislative hold up. There was no public notice of the meeting printed, and the public and the populists of the state never knew that there was to be a meeting until it was over with and the report furnished the press by the secretary was printed. The three national committeemen for Oregon who are also members of the state central committee, were not invited to this secret meeting. The names of those present were the same "push" that camped at Salem last winter and held up the state and lived high on "a fund raised by enemies of Mitchell." They slid out of their respective neighborhoods on their free passes and nobody knew their mission until it was over.

SILVER REPUBLICANS.

An organization of the Ohio Silver Republican party has been effected. One of the promoters says:

"We mean business, and if we cannot get what we want—the recognition of silver—from the Republican party, we will go where we can get it. The Republican party, like the Democratic party as represented in the late administration, has been led astray, and I think I see in the near future an amalgamation of the gold Democrats and gold Republicans, and the joining of the silver Democrats and silver Republicans."

The Louisville Courier-Journal Monday morning contained a sensational editorial from Henry Waterson. He says the Reform Club of New York, on Saturday night, started the campaign of 1900 on behalf of Cleveland, mentioning whose name now is a reproach. Cleveland has had his day—a sad day for his party. He never effected genuine reform except for ill. Waterson then scores Cleveland's followers, whose purpose is to Mexicanize the public administration, keeping him in power, like Diaz, during the term of his natural life.

Baker City Republican: It is evident that the appropriations heretofore secured by Congressman Hermann for Yaquina and the Willamette river will not be expended. Parties interested down that way will soon realize that they have no member of the committee on rivers and harbors. The Salem papers are not shouting themselves hoarse about improving the Willamette river just now.

The "concert of the powers" in regard to Turkey and Greece is in reality a "concert" of the counting rooms. Turkey is in debt to European financial magnates about \$700,000,000. The magnates control the other governments, to a great extent, and every effort will be made to keep the security as good as possible by preventing further spoliation of Turkish territory.

Salem hop men are contracting the coming crop at 8 cents. We advise our hop growers to let these contracts severely alone. If hops are a good price they honor their contracts. If a poor price they leave them on the growers hands.

Millions of bushels of Nebraska corn lie on the ground where it was husked and has lain all winter. It will be destroyed by the spring rains, and yet it does not pay to move it at the market gold standard price of 8 cents per bushel.

Reports are occasionally heard that Gov Lord will call an extra session of the legislature to elect or attempt to elect a senator. It is probable such rumors are without foundation.

Oregon rarely fails when rain is wanted. Crops may be short occasionally, yet never failures on account of lack of moisture.
