THE QUESTION OF THE PHILIPPINES. Will the Anglo Saxon Colonize Them?

There is no question as to our duty to provide the Philippines with as stable a government as possible. But there is a question as to the advisability of permanently holding conquered territory the control of which rests with a standing army which very competent military authorities say will be required to govern those islands.

Our government is one of the people, founded on the intelligence of the people. The present population of the Philippines, mixed bloods of Malay and Asiatic races, cannot be depended upon to govern themselves. Is it probable any considerable immigration will leave our shores to make homes among strange people and tongues, in an already densely populated territory where all conditions of life are entirely dissimilar, and where a tropic sun looks down with untamed ferocity?

The great problem that lies before our people in dealing with this question is not one of "imperialism" or "territorial expansion" but of the fitness of our new possessions for colonization and home building by the Anglo Saxon.

JUDGE HAMILTON AND THE BRANTON APPEAL.

The Salem Journal is of the opinion that a circuit judge who has carefully tried a murder case, resulting in conviction of the accused, should certify "probable cause" for reversal of the judgment of his court.

The case in question, that of Claude Branton, was carefully tried by Judge Hamilton, a lawyer who

for nearly twenty years devoted much attention to criminal practice both as prosecuting attorney, and a pleader before the bar for an alleged accused persons.

What is a judge for? To carefully try a case then turn about and say he probably had done wrong? That is what the Journal would ask of Judge Hamilton.

PRESIDENT M'KINLEY ON OUR NATIONAL DUTY.

(From Augusta, Ga. Speech.)

"Thus far we have done our supreme duty. Shall we now, when the victory won in war is written in the treaty of peace and the civilized world applauds and waits in expectation, turn timidly away from the duties imposed upon the country by its own great deeds?
