MAKES AN OFFER

Dr. Russell Wants Marion County's Sick
Paupers.

Salem Journal.

"It is not generally known that
Marion is keeping one indigent person
in an infirmary near Eugene, Lane
county, kept by Dr. Benjamin Frank-
lin Russell, M. D., for \$4 a week. She
is boarded, lodged, treated and cared
for by Dr. Russell for that sum, he
furnishing everything.

"Mrs. McDonald is addicted to opium
in its different forms, and the doctor
thinks she will undoubtedly become
demented if she does not stop the use
of it. (The bill for her care should be
charged to the doctor who got her in
the way of using it.)

"Dr. Russell writes to the Marion
county court: 'I would also state to ye
honorable body that if you have any
other cases female or male, diseased or
not diseased, crippled or not crippled,
I will take them at \$5 per week and do
for Marion county as I have for Lane
county.'

"Dr. Russell is devoting his time to
the poor, and says he believes he can
benefit the county, the patients and
himself, and includes in the service he
offers all expenses of burial in case of
death.

"The county court is impressed with
the business like proposition contained
in Dr. Russell's letter. The cost of
keeping the poor at the Marion county
poor house is \$2.25 for board and
lodging, medical attendance and
hospital bills being extra when re-
quired. The county court is trying to
evolve a plan to trade off the present
poor house property at Salem and get
a farm in the country where there
would be work for the well and an in-
firmity, run like the one in Lane
county for a nominal expense. There
is a chance for some enterprising med-
ical man to make Marion county a
proposition like the one made by Dr.
Russell, of Eugene."

SUSLAU RIVER IMPROVEMENT

Plans of Captain Hart Approved—7700
Feet of Jetties.

\$30,000 FOR THE YEAR

A Washington dispatch of April 7
says the plans of Captain Hart for the
improvement of the Suslaw bar has
been approved by the chief of engineers
of the war department.

For the Suslaw there has been appro-
priated \$30,000. The project at this
point provides for confining the out-
going and incoming waters at the
mouth of the stream in the Pacific
ocean between two high-tide rubble-
stone jetties, converging until they are
60 feet apart at the crest of the bar.
The north jetty is to be 4500 feet long,
with a tramway 3000 feet long. The
south jetty 3200 feet in length, with a
2400 foot tramway. Each jetty is to be
built from a pile tramway, extending
along the line of the proposed jetty,
and each will be 10 feet wide at the
top of high tide. They are designed to
secure a depth on the bar of eight feet
at low tide. This work completed will
cost \$700,000. So far operations have
been confined to the construction of
the north jetty, and the north jetty
approach has been built throughout its
entire length, the north jetty itself
being built up to high tide for a dis-
tance of 911 feet. The jetty has not
been extended out to sea a sufficient
distance to cause any appreciable im-
crease in the depth of the water on the
bar, but it has been instrumental in
holding the channel in one place.

With the new appropriation it is pro-
posed to make minor repairs to the
wharf at the shore end of the north
jetty tramway, and to the tramway
itself, which were rendered necessary
by storms. The north jetty tramway
is to be extended for a distance of
about 500 feet, and the north jetty for
an equal distance, by dumping rubble-
stone from the tramway. This work
during the coming fiscal year will cost
about \$30,000, and will be done by con-
tract. Specifications are now being
prepared, and will soon be submitted
to the chief of engineers for approval;
the project itself having already been
approved.
