SIDE NOTES.

The Branton Execution From a Distance of Twenty Four Hours.

Two errors made in yesterday's report should be corrected, (1) Courtland Green is not a relative of S. Smeed, (2) the remains of Branton were not interred in the Pleasant Hill cemetery as at first intended but at the Camp Creek cemetery.

Branton neither smoked, drank nor was he addicted to the use of profane language.

The scaffold and enclosure were torn down today removing from sight the suggestion of a gruesome act. The trap was stowed away. The rope used in the execution was not cut up and distributed as usually the case, but laid away with the trap. A small piece of the same rope about 4 inches in length, but not used, was secured and passed around.

By instructions of Branton a sealed message was delivered to Rev Patterson by Sheriff Withers after the execution. Its contents will not be made known. By some the message is presumed to be a confession.

A large number of extra copies of the GUARD of yesterday were printed. Each subscriber to the WEEKLY GUARD in Lane county was mailed a copy; hundreds of extras were sold.

A load of responsibility was lifted from the Lane county officials, responsible for the care of Branton, by the execution.

Judge Potter informs us that the parties who witnessed the execution of Claude Branton from the court house tower were Janitor Doyle and wife, and no one else.

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ORDERED COMMITTED.—Mrs Fannie Hanovan made application yesterday to the county judge, asking that he order the following of her children sent to the Boys and Girls Aid Society, of Portland: Sadie Hanovan, 14 years, Edie, 12 years, Mauda 9 years, Ora, 10, and David 7. The application cited the facts that her husband, seven of them being minors, and that she was unable to properly support, educate and maintain them. Judge Potter granted her request and appointed J. M. Williams to execute the order; therefore he will take them to Portland tomorrow to place them in the care and custody of said society.

CITY OF EUGENE.—The steambot City of Eugene, the pride of Lane county, arrived here this morning at 7:30 o'clock from Portland with a good load of freight for our merchants. She had way freight for Salem, Albany and Corvallis and three car loads, for Monroe landing. Besides this she towed a scow from Oregon City to Salem and another from Salem to Albany. She was also compelled to leave 20 tons of freight on her dock at Portland. Notwithstanding the fight by the leading corporations, her business is increasing rapidly. She will leave for down river points Monday morning at 7 o'clock.

MERELY A RUMOR.—In its report of the execution of Branton the Junction City Times says: "The report was current here that a large crowd of cowboys from over the mountains were in the city from Linn's home, and had Branton's sentence been commuted he would have been lynched. Fortunately the law was allowed to take its course, and the murderer met his just deserts." This is a mistake as there were no cowboys from east of the mountains in the city.

CLOSED TO BICYCLES.—Bohemia Nugget May 12: "The city council convened last Tuesday night and transacted the usual amount of business coming before it. Among the important things done was a ruling which is of interest to bicyclists of Cottage Grove. It was ordered that bicyclists be prohibited from riding on the walk west as far as Dr. Williams' residence, and on west main street as far as Mrs. Sanford's; also as far north as the north side of Bohemia Nugget office."

NO RELATION.—The GUARD report of the Branton execution, and crime leading thereto, fell into a previous error of giving Mr. Stephen Smeed of Waverlyville, as the uncle of Courtney Green. The previous mistake was promptly corrected, but the attention of the reporter who wrote up the execution had not been called to the correction, and he fell into the previous error. No relationship whatever exists between Green and Mr. Smeed.

DIED.—Cottage Grove Leader: Mrs. Stella Kennedy, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Wm. Landess, of Cottage Grove, died at Medford, May 6, 1899, aged 27 years, 2 months and 23 days. Mrs. Kennedy was born in Polk county, Oregon, Feb. 13, 1872, and was married to J. E. Kennedy, Oct. 14, 1894. Having spent most of her girlhood days in Cottage Grove, she leaves many friends together with her relatives to mourn her departure.

MAYBE HOME TALENT.—Bohemia Nugget May 12: For some time store robbing has been quite a pastime in Cottage Grove. It has been suggested that traps were the perpetrators of these crimes. While we are suggesting let's suggest to look a little nearer home. Traps, like lightning don't hit the same place twice, as a rule, especially in an interval of ten days.
