## TREASURE FROM DAWSON.

Two Millions in Gold Said to Be Coming to Seattle—Largest Single Shipment of Season.

SEATTLE, Aug. 10.—Late advices from the north state that a single shipment of \$1,000,000 in treasure will soon be made from Dawson to this city. According to the plans of D. C. Jackson, superintendent of the Alaska Express, which has the shipment in charge, the gold will arrive here in about 10 days. The treasure is consigned to the local assay office from the Canadian Bank of Commerce at Dawson, which corporation purchased it from miners in small lots. The shipment will, perhaps be the largest or one of the largest single shipments of the season.

Another \$1,000,000 in treasure left Dawson July 20, on a down-river steamer, and should arrive here on one of the next boats via St. Michael; \$750,000 of it belongs to the same bank as is making the above shipment.
