PASSING THE GOOD THINGS ABOUT.

Portland will not get all the legislative clerkships the coming session of the state legislature, as in the past. The Kuykendall law provides:

"In the senate, the officers, except the president and the three pages, being 80 in number, shall be elected one from each senatorial district of the state, if there be a competent applicant from such district. In the house of representatives, the officers shall be elected from the various counties of the state, in the proportion that such county is represented in that body, so far as possible, provided there be competent applicants from the several counties."

AGAINST HIS COUSIN.

Preston H McKinley, a cousin of President McKinley, and a wealthy stock raiser of Freeport, Harper county, Kansas, according to an interview in the New York Journal, rejects the Republican ticket and declares his purpose to vote for Bryan and Stevenson. He says he would rather have the Prince of Wales president of the United States than his cousin. He said: "In 1896 I worked and voted for McKinley for president. I thought he would make a better president than he has, but I find he caters too much to European style, which I and every other American do not like. I believe the Prince of Wales knows better how to conduct this republic than does my cousin. I should rather vote for him anyhow. McKinley and imperialism will defeat the Republican party at the polls this fall. I will vote for Bryan and Stevenson in order to help save the republic."

Umatilla county people are trying to escape their just share of state taxation. The assessment for this year shows a falling off of about \$1,000,000, a seventh compared with last year. If Umatilla, with good crops, gets a reduction of one-seventh, Lane county is entitled to a one-half reduction. It is not probable, though, that the state board of equalization can be made to see it that way.

The German editors of Wisconsin have just closed a session of their editorial association. Two out of the twenty-five present made a lame apology for the Anglo-American alliance, imperialism, etc. The

rest are all opposed, and each reported the Germans of his section as unwisely solid for Bryan.

David Hill has tendered his services to the national and state committees to make a thorough canvass of Indiana in the interest of the presidential and state ticket. Dave Hill is not "sulking" this year. He is full of fight and will lend strength to the Bryan cause.
