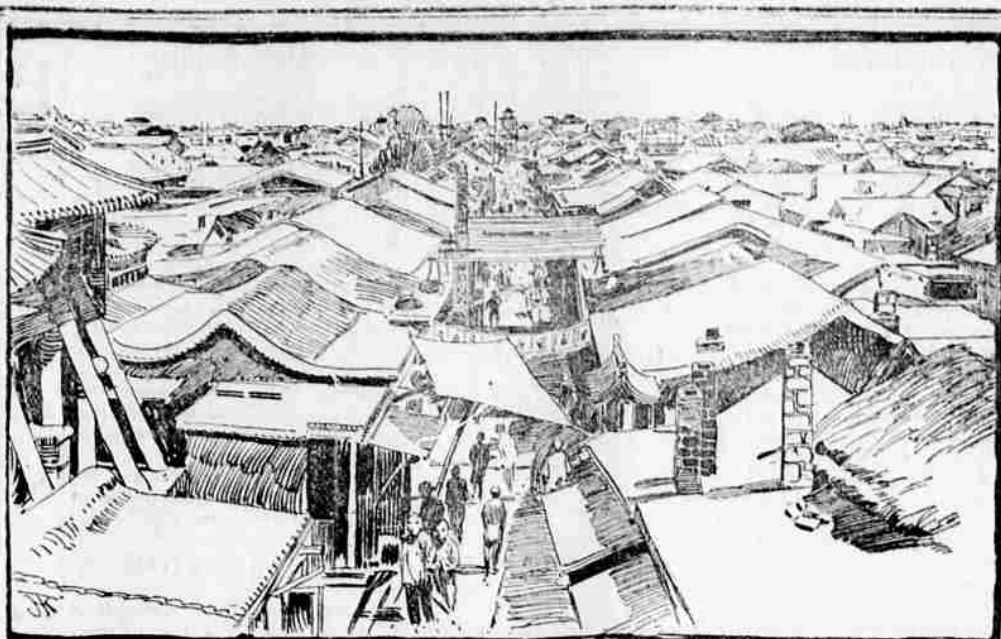

WILL RUN TO SALEM.

Steamer City of Eugene Will Again Go Into Commission. Portland Telegram, August 30. The Oregon City Transportation Co. has secured the freight steamer City of Eugene and will operate her between Portland and Salem. The first trip will be made the latter part of the present week. The City of Eugene has had a checkered career. She was built in the early part of 1890 at Eugene, by a syndicate. She was operated for a time with varying success, and was finally sold by the United States Marshal to satisfy a claim for wages due the crew. She was purchased by Olsen & Co., and later was sold to the Spaulding Logging Co. For several months she has been tied up at the levee.

The Robertson Raft Company's log raft arrived at San Francisco from the Columbia river in safety, but it is doubtful if the promoters will ever attempt it again. Telegrams from many points along the Coast state that logs have been repeatedly run into by ships, showing that they have been scattered far and wide over the ocean. The raft contained 12,000 logs or 1,000,000 feet of piling and was constructed in the form of a huge cigar. Another large raft is being constructed on Puget Sound with the intention of towing it to San Francisco.
