WILD GAME ON INCREASE.

Deer and Bear Very Numerous at Lake Creek, in Lane County.

GREENLEAF, Or., Aug. 26.—Wild game seems to be increasing in numbers on Lake Creek, in Lane County. Sportsmen who come from the valley to hunt every summer are surprised at the steady increase of deer in the face of the fact that the settlers kill them with impunity at all times of the year. Passers along the roads see bands of deer almost every day. Bears also seem more numerous than ever, though a good many are killed every year. They seldom attack domestic stock, keeping to the woods, where they feed on berries and wild game. Cougars, which formerly were in these woods in large numbers, seem to be growing scarcer, perhaps because, being destructive to sheep, goats, calves and the like, they are hunted more assiduously than bears. Sportsmen find a slight decrease in the number of fish in the streams.

Having Gay Time in Paris.
