## UNDERTAKERS IN DANGER.

### A Large Junket Party Nearly Met Death on Pike's Peak.

CHICAGO, Oct 11.—A special to the Times-Herald from Colorado Springs, Col., says: Pike's Peak was the scene of a thrilling and desperate adventure that befell the delegates to the National convention of undertakers. The party, including many of the wives of the delegates, and in all over 200 strong, had a narrow escape in a terrific storm that swept over the mountain side. Many of the weaker persons were partially overcome by the cold and blinding snow. The National Association, which has just closed its annual convention, went off on a junket to the points of interest about the state, which included a trip to the summit of Pike's Peak, although it is somewhat late for that altitude.

When at an elevation of 10,000 feet the engine of the cogway train became disabled. The weather was fine and no one objected to finishing the trip afoot. But in less than a mile they were overtaken by a furious blizzard. The situation was growing dangerous, when a relief came from a train sent for the purpose. Several of the women fainted during the storm.

TRENTON, N. J., Oct 11.—Judge Kirkpatrick, in the United States Court, refusing naturalization papers to Robert Spaulding (color d), a native of Dutch Guiana. The papers were refused on the ground that the Federal laws permit the naturalization of white males only.

Spaulding is a graduate of Howard university, Washington, D. C. and is now a student of Princeton university, and had expected to take up the study of law. His inability to become naturalized will prevent his admission to the bar.

## The Albany Acetylene Gas Accident.

The Albany Democrat of yesterday, Oct 11, gives full particulars of the fatal acetylene gas explosion which occurred in that city yesterday, a telegraphic account of which was published in the GUARD. The Democrat says:

"Steven Stoltz, the plumber, of Ferry street, and Fred Reis, the saloon keeper, this forenoon went down into the basement under Reis' saloon to take out an old acetylene gas tank when an accident occurred, resulting in the death of Stoltz and serious injuries to Reis. Mr Reis at one time lighted his pipe with acetylene gas, having the tank in the ground beneath the building. A year ago he took the plant out in order to use electricity, leaving the tank. It was supposed that the tank was empty, but the dampness of the cellar had generated the gas, and when the men were taking off the top of the tank, there was an awful explosion and the men were thrown some distance. Mr Reis was able to reach the sidewalk through the side door and secured help to bring Stoltz out. It was found that the auxiliary artery under Stoltz' left arm was completely shattered and he soon bled to death, living only a short time. Reis' injuries were not so serious, though his face was badly cut up and bruised, evidently the side of the tank hitting him, while a sharp part of the top struck Stoltz.

"At the time of the accident three men were carrying wood into the basement and also assisting in carrying some of the acetylene gas plant up stairs. Stoltz had his left arm on the tank and was bending over working at a pipe which he was unloosening, while Mr Reis was a little back of him. The candle was on the tank. Mr Reis cried out that he was killed, but Stoltz never made a cry. One of the men was knocked against the wall by the concussion. A six inch post was knocked down."
