WM. J. BRYAN
Offered Several Editorial Positions at Large Salaries.
DENVER, Colo., Nov. 10.—Colonel W. J. Bryan has declined an offer of an editorial position on a Denver afternoon newspaper at a salary of \$10,000 a year. In his reply, which was telegraphed from Lincoln, Neb., today, he says:
"I shall remain here, and in the future, as in the past, defend with tongue and pen the principles which I believe to be right and the policies I believe to be wise."
On the top of the foregoing comes the statement from Washington, D. C., that W. R. Hearst, proprietor of the San Francisco Examiner, New York Journal and Chicago American, is to begin the publication of a daily paper at the national capital within the next month, his editor-in-chief to be William Jennings Bryan. Bryan's salary, it is said, will be \$25,000 a year.
