THE NEW ARMORY.

Furnishings to Be Procured Soon—Opening Further Delayed.

At a meeting of the Eugene Military Club held Friday night, the committee appointed to ascertain the cost of furnishing the new armory made their report. The club authorized the board of trustees, Col Moran and the captains of the different military companies to act in conjunction in procuring the furnishings at the earliest possible date so as to be ready to install them as soon as the work is completed on the interior of the armory which, on account of the slowness in procuring materials, has been delayed considerably and will be some time before it is finished.

It has been generally reported; that the opening ball to be given in the new armory will occur on the evening of February 22nd, but a prominent member of the military club informs us that it will hardly be possible to have it by that time. He said that the military organizations would not be occupying their new quarters by that time, and that it would not be practicable to give the ball for at least two weeks after that date, so that everything would be in good shape and nothing would detract from the success of the affair.

SEMI-ANNUAL PAYMENT

Of Taxes Better Suited to Majority of Taxpayers.

Quite a demand is being made by taxpayers in this county for an amendment to the present laws regarding the collection of taxes, making the taxes payable in two installments. It is argued that many taxpayers find it more or less burdensome to raise money for the payment of their taxes all at one time, and that it would be a great relief to have the laws amended so that a portion of the amount could be paid in the spring and the remainder in the fall. If the taxes are to be paid in one lump it is averred that it would be an accommodation to the average taxpayer to have that payable in October or November, instead of in the spring of the year, as at present, for the reason that after harvest is the time when farmers have ready money from the sale of their crops. But the demand is for the taxes to be made payable in two installments, one-half in the early summer and the remainder in the fall.

The expense of maintaining schools in Porto Rico is very high, if we consider the amount spent for the small number of pupils enrolled; but as that country is gradually brought in closer touch with our own, their system will evidently be changed, until it reaches our present state of perfection. Griffith's Wild Ride.

Griffith, the eminent American hypnotist, who by virtue of his wonderful speed and rapidity, has created so much excitement in the cities of the West this season, is booked for a three nights stay at The Parker commencing Thursday, Jan 24th. During his stay here he will, it is advertised, undertake one of the most difficult features known to the phenomena of mental telepathy, the Blindfold Drive, where in a committee selected from the business element will drive a spirited team over a circuitous route of 15 blocks and at the conclusion hide some article, a pin or pen knife or other small article. While this is being done the professor will be in the hands of another committee whose business it will be to keep him in ignorance of the route taken by the first committee or of the place in which the article is secured. After the article has been hid Mr Griffith will take the team, and after being securely blindfolded, drive the team at a hurried rate of speed over the exact route taken and find the article. This feature is a very remarkable one when it is remembered that the only contact used in the test is a small copper wire which is looped about the professor's forehead and then indirectly attached to the committeemen. The feature will take place at 3:30 p m, starting from the front of the postoffice on Saturday.
