Cool Weather Detrimental to All Crops.

CHERRY DROP LIGHT.

SALEM, June 5.—Grain fields on the Marion county prairie are not showing as heavy a stand as was expected. The grain on summer fallow is ahead of other fields, especially where the land was summer fallowed early and harrowed down well.

Hop yards as a whole show up finely. Many of the old yards show a good stand of vines, but are making poor growth and no signs of apple have yet appeared. The general opinion is that good prices will prevail.

The Italian prune crop will be a record breaker and the Petite and Silver prunes are showing a better prospect, although thin in places. The cherry crop that promised to be heavy early in the season, now gives signs of being light. Apples are showing a better yield than was expected but there will not be half a crop, though of excellent quality. Cool weather throughout the week has been detrimental to all crops.
