TROUBLE AHEAD.

Looks Like the Cattle Men Would Protect Their Herds.

Special to Guard.
Pendleton, Or, June 19.—The Camas Valley Stock Protective Association has held another meeting at Ukiah, 50 miles south from here in this county. Men have been appointed to ride the range and enforce the regulations recently promulgated to protect the settlers there from outside sheep and cattle owners' bands. A correspondent of the East Oregonian sends a statement that it is now believed that the differences will be amicably adjusted, and that no trouble is looked for. The valley has been districted, and an agreement will be reached as to where outside men shall range their livestock.
No one there appears to anticipate violence, all reports to the contrary, notwithstanding. The settlers are excellent, law-abiding men, and will not court an infraction of the statutes.

OREGON INDIAN FIGHTING.

The White Politicians at Pendleton Hired to Scheme.

Special to the Guard.
PENDLETON, Or, June 12.—For ten weeks past the Cayuses have been trying to elect a chief. Young Culet died last January, and he was the usurping head of the nation, having been elected, so Paul Showaway claims, and not having hereditary rights like those which Showaway says are his. The election has been the occasion for much jockeying by the various leaders of factions, and not less than ten times has the election been postponed.
After endless bickerings and delays, it was decided last week that on Tuesday, June 11, the election must occur, no further delays being permitted. All factions were notified to be on hand with their votes. The choice was to be made with ballot, in imitation of the whites, and this seemed to please all the candidates. But Chief No Shirt, of the Walla Walla tribe, who is the paramount chief on the reservation by reason of the fact that his is the largest tribe, refused to give consent to the innovation. He demanded that Indian tradition be observed, which would bring the tribesmen together in solemn council, which would send about the pipe of peace and end in the choice of a chief by expression of opinion, the influential men overweighing those of less years and experience.

The adherents of the modern method were disconcerted by No Shirt's prohibition, and the approach of Tuesday, election day, was cause for perturbation and much electioneering. A dozen white men of Pendleton were called in to assist in devising schemes on one or the other side, so that the event, in itself of no importance, assumed formidable proportions and became the subject for quite general conversation in this town.
The adherents of the modern method were disconcerted by No Shirt's prohibition, and the approach of Tuesday, election day, was cause for perturbation and much electioneering. A dozen white men of Pendleton were called in to assist in devising schemes on one or the other side, so that the event, in itself of no importance, assumed formidable proportions and became the subject for quite general conversation in this town.
