SOME BIG STRIKES.

The strike of the Amalgamated Ironworker's Association makes figures as to strikes of recent years interesting. Here are the principal ones: Great railroad strike of 1877, estimated 150,000 men out. Telegraphers' strike, 1883, 6,270 men out. Gould System strike, 1885, Martin Irons, 4,000 men out. Reading Railroad strike, 1887, 6,500 men out. Miners', Pittsburg coal region, 1889, 85,000 men out. Homestead lockout, 3,000, and sympathetic strike, 6,100; total, 9,900 men out. Railroad strike, Chicago, Debs, 100,000 men out. Anthracite coal miners, 1900, 141,500 men out.

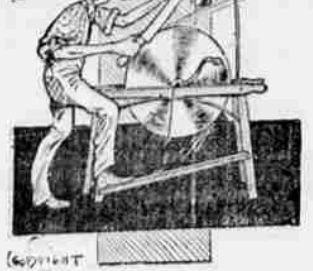

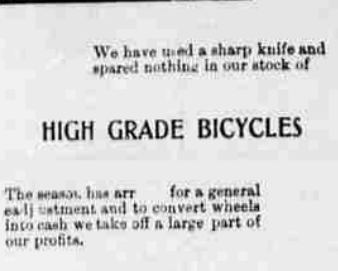
