Senator Mitchell has introduced a bill in the senate prohibiting Chinese, Japanese and Filipinos coming into the United States. How is this? We thought the Philippine islands were a portion of the United States.

It has been nearly one hundred and twenty-eight years since patriotic Bostonians threw a cargo of tea into the harbor waters as an earnest that they would have none of King George's stamp tax. Monday is the anniversary of that event.

Oregon people have secured contracts for the furnishing of about four thousand tons of hay and oats, principally the latter, for early delivery at Portland for shipment to the Philippines. It is being bought by the government for army supplies.

A wealthy Portland woman who travels much makes one good use of her wealth in sending choice trees, shrubs and plants she observes in other localities to the Portland park authorities for planting. A thoughtful as well as generous woman.

The State Board of Agriculture is naturally well pleased to be able to make mention in its annual report, just issued, that the 1901 state fair had an excess of nearly four hundred dollars of receipts over expenditures. Usually it has been the other way.

The attorney-general earns the gratitude of teachers by an opinion that the temporary closing of a school by order of the board of directors on account of an epidemic of disease does not work any forfeiture of salary during the period the school remains closed.

Andrew Carnegie makes the offer of ten millions for a national university to be located at Washington. The acceptance of the endowment and control of the Smithsonian Institute is a precedent that will likely influence the acceptance of the multi-millionaire Scotchman.

In a recent general estimate of the wealth of millionaires that of J Pierpont Morgan, a leading trust promoter, is placed at four hundred millions. Working at ten dollars a week one would have to labor eight hundred thousand years to earn that amount. The vastness of the sum is simply inconceivable.

Of the nine million negroes on the census rolls eight million are in the south, the inequality of distribution being due to climatic conditions besides being the heritage of slavery. Notwithstanding this great preponderance of colored population "down south" there are occasional northern "philanthropists" who, at long distance from the black centers of population, affect full knowledge of the best manner by which the diverse

aces may be harmonized in their daily contact and necessarily close business and labor relations.

A Southern Oregon pioneer tells how the town of Kerby, formerly called Kerbyville, got its location. Referring to a pioneer billiard table of the town he said: "That old table was brought over from Crescent City on the back of a packmule. Anita was the old mule's name; she was the favorite pack-mule of Martinez, an old Southern Oregon and California packer. He was under contract to deliver the table to Althouse for a saloonkeeper over there. The old mule caved in under the big package when she got this far with it. The saloonkeeper wouldn't pay Martinez because he hadn't delivered the table, so Martinez built a saloon around it advertised a 'grand opening,' and got the stamped headed his way. The town of Kerbyville built up around the saloon, and soon became the liveliest mining camp north of 'Fricco. Martinez and his saloon, with the only billiard table north of 'Fricco as a drawing card, were the center of the attraction.'
