A MOHAWK VALLEY TRIP.

Some Things a Reporter Saw About Marcola and in Lane County.

W J Cuddy in Oregonian.

When Hon Jeff Meyers told at Charleston of the good roads of Oregon he had in mind the roads in his neighborhood. The same condition prevails throughout the valley. A stone's throw from the railroad station (if you throw it far enough) the change begins. There being no Sunday train on the branch, we left Eugene at 7 for a 25-mile drive to Wendling, assured by our driver, Harvey Jones, a Philippine veteran, who got as far as Vancouver and Fort Crook before being mustered out, that four hours at the most would put us into the town.

Wendling is a wonder to a city man. The Booth-Kelly Company is the town. It employs from 250 to 300 men and ships all its product. Just now the mill is running on a 250,000 feet ca-siding order for Michigan.

The Wendling mill is one process of evolution. A quarter of a century ago C W Holcomb built a little mill and sawed out 3000 feet a day of fencing, selling it all at \$10 to settler, who dressed it or not as they needed. He stayed with it, gave his 10 boys and girls the very best education, and now, as he approaches his three-score and ten, is proud of his children, his grandchildren and his town.

Machinery and improved processes have worked wonders in the sawmill. Where Mr Holcomb laboriously sawed out his fencing, now steam does it with a clatter, rattle and snarl. A 40-foot log, three feet in diameter, is railroaded out of the pond, rolled into place, cut by the bandsaw into lumber, and the slabs worked into laths and tied in bundles—all in so short a time that one thinks that in a little while longer all the timber will be gone.

Farms are plenty along the Mohawk. Fall grain is in fine condition. Hops and orchards are numerous. The farm houses are well built and roomy, and so are the barns, because lumber is handy and cheap. Thrift is everywhere. The hen is in evidence—thoroughbred kinds, too. Coming back by train, we stopped at a place called Marcola (which I hereby solemnly change to Deephola—remembering the mud we drove through).

I have always wanted to see what might be called the back yard of the valley, so I come down the Woodburn branch. Springfield and Coburg are sawmill towns of the Booth-Kelly Company. Work is plenty in both places and large amounts of lumber are turned out.

A word to trout fishermen. When the time comes, go to Eugene on the night train, cross over to Springfield the next morning and go up the branch. Get off where it crosses the McKenzie and fish. They tell me they catch plenty of redear trout.
