CELEBRATED HER MISFORTUNE.

Cottage Grove celebrated the commencement of work on the railroad from that point to the Bohemia mining district today with music, speechmaking and powder. It will not be many months before the residents who shouted themselves hoarse will say with Shakespeare's "Puck," "what fools these mortals be."

Now Cottage Grove is the main supply point for everything used in the mines, at least all teaming and men going into and coming out from Bohemia must stop and pay tribute there. After the railroad the cars for Bohemia will pass through Cottage Grove just the same as they pass through Eugene and other points on the line. Cottage Grove has celebrated her greatest misfortune.

GOLDWIN SMITH ON EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENTS.

Professor Goldwin Smith, the eminent and venerable English scholar and writer on political economy, who was for many years an Oxford professor, has this to say about the inter-educational scheme in Cecil Rhodes' will—that of providing Oxford scholarships for American students:

"My opinion has been sometimes asked as to the expediency of sending young Americans or Canadians to be educated in England. I have always given it in the negative, holding it to be best for a youth to be brought up and to have his ideas and sympathies formed in the social and political elements in which his life is to be spent."

That seems sound. Following this same line of thought would it not be well that the professors and teachers should hold a natural sympathy with the students they would teach? In other words, to make a local application of Professor Smith's observation, the young manhood and womanhood of Oregon could best receive their university education under the direction of a president whose social and other sympathies are one with theirs. Professor Smith is not in

favor of American students being sent to the great English university.

Our people do not favor the importation of university presidents from the East, with whom there is no bond of community feeling.

A few scores of miles in the interior of Alaska, near the head of Sunshine River, and north of the head of Cook Inlet, is an enormous mountain mass, the central and highest peak of which is Mount McKinley, 20,464 feet in height.

No attempt has yet been made to scale this great mountain; indeed, no one has yet approached it nearer than forty miles, the height having been determined by vertical angles taken at that distance. Even the camera lens has not succeeded in stealing his portrait.

A strike of plasterers delaying building construction calls attention to the vast building interests of New York City. Work on one hundred large buildings are delayed, while there are a dozen "skyscrapers" already behind time.

Fourteen mammoth office buildings costing \$24,000,000, under contract to be completed May 1st, must take their time with the exception of two which are practically finished.

Butte Montana has a sensation in the charges of two attorneys in the big copper mining suits where millions are involved, that the trial judge was unduly influenced by a woman in the employ of the plaintiff, who gained the suit. The attorneys were fined \$500 each and ordered imprisoned twenty-four hours.

The home of the parent Presbyterian church of New York City has been closed after forty-three years of service. It is the old story—location shut in by business property, and ground become very valuable. A syndicate paid one million dollars for the property.

Three Umatilla county boys have been making pocket money digging out young coyotes. They got twelve in one litter the other day.
