There are indications that the Great Central railway from Salt Lake to this place is assuming definite shape.

Grants Pass is getting more than her share of fires. Only two years ago a great portion of the business property was swept. The big mill burned only a few weeks ago. Monday several houses went and the whole town was threatened. But the people have spirit and enterprise, and the embers scarcely die away until better buildings take the place of the old.

Many papers now argue that blood hounds are worthless in running down criminals. Let the dumb beasts be given due credit. There is no question about their instinctively following a trail when they have it; and they follow a trail that no other detective could discover. But in order to capture the game, men must go with the hounds, and it is sometimes hazardous business.

The manner in which whole communities suffer at times as the result of immense institutions contending for trifles is illustrated in the freight handlers strike in Chicago. On the one side are ten thousand men contending for one-half cent per hour more pay than they are offered; and on the other side are ten great railroad companies opposing this demand of half a cent. But while this is going on the wholesale business of that great city is paralyzed, and the loss to the merchants is not less than \$1,000,000 every day.

We doubt if many, if any, cases are on record that will compare with the action of the Portland criminal, Belding. That he should attempt to kill and exterminate a whole family with whom he had standing trouble for years, is not different from what might be expected from many other men. But others would be expected either to complete the bloody job by using a bullet on their own head, else make some attempt to escape. But this man boasts that he is too much of a man to commit suicide, and too brave to attempt to evade the law, and coolly and without apparent fear invites the execution of the death penalty according to law. He is in this respect a freak among criminals.

The citizens of this community should miss no opportunity to get a good railroad to this point from some point like Salt Lake or Winnemucca. The whole state of Oregon is vitally interested in the development of the immense resources of Southeastern Oregon, which have been retarded or prevented from becoming known as they should for want of transportation facilities. Indeed, many look upon the vast territory comprising Klamath, Crook, Lake, Harney and Malheur counties as good for nothing except for producing sage brush, alkali and jackrabbits, with now and then a patch that will support a few cattle or sheep.

Such is not the case, however. That whole country is full of resources, which only want transportation facilities to ensure their rapid development. There now being a strong probability of one of the great railway systems building across this stretch of virgin territory, crossing the Cascade by the Middle Fork pass, then seeking the seaboard probably at both Portland and Coos Bay, the people should rejoice at the era of development it will surely open.

We know the railroad company is not doing this on account of its

love for the dear people, but there may be rejoicing just the same. It is a good business proposition for the Missouri Pacific people. The business to be made along the line from here to Salt Lake in hauling passengers, lumber, grain, stock and other farm products, merchandise and supplies back will in great probability be sufficient to sustain the road. In addition to this it will give the company an outlet to the coast and put it in position for profitably handling transcontinental business in competition with other roads. The early completion of such a road is earnestly hoped for.

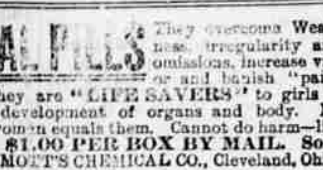
