A Labor Famine

Probably never before in the history of this country has there been such a widespread and universal demand for labor as there is today. Moreover, it is absolutely impossible to meet the demand. It is conservatively estimated that 1,500,000 more men are wanted to supply the demand for help in the various industries of the country. Particularly are skilled workmen wanted by the thousands.

The New York Commercial has been looking into the subject and says: "While strikes and the agitation of labor questions continue to be a menace to industrial prosperity in this country, a far more serious problem confronting employers and capitalists today is the purely economic one of an adequate supply of skilled labor just now in all lines of production."

"It is a most alarming fact—one that has only recently been disclosed as the result of a painstaking investigation and one that cannot be refuted—that many millions of American capital are today lying idle and unproductive simply because its owners prefer not to risk its employment in industrial enterprises that are already suffering from this skilled labor famine."

But the Commercial goes further and prints reports from all over the country showing a lack of all kinds of labor. There are workers wanted in the cotton mills, in the linen mill, collar and shirt factories—in West, in South, and everywhere.

It is no new cry that there are not enough farm hands to gather the crops of the great West, but New England farms, those abandoned farms, are asking help, and \$45 per month and board are offered.

It is a marvelous situation. With a million annual increase in population and a million immigrants, 600,000 of whom are males, yet we are in the throes of a labor famine without any sign of relief.
