Board of Equalization.

Notice is hereby given that on the last Monday in August, 1905, the board of equalization will meet at the office of the county clerk of Lane county, Oregon, and publicly examine the assessment rolls and correct all errors in valuation, description or quantities of lands, lots or other property, and it shall be the duty of persons interested to appear at the time and place appointed, and if it shall appear to such board of equalization that there are any lands, lots or other property assessed twice, or in the name of a person or persons not the owner thereof, or assessed under or beyond its actual value, or any lands, lots or other property not assessed said board shall make the proper corrections.

Said board of equalization shall continue its sittings from day to day, until the examination and correction of the assessment rolls, as provided by law, shall be completed.
