Money Thrown Away

The county court has simply thrown away \$8000 to \$10,000 in contracting to pay men to cruise the timber lands of this county at \$3 per section. Any one who has any knowledge of timber cruising knows that \$20 a section for reliable work would be cheap, consequently the work for \$3 per section will not benefit the county a particle. Good work cannot be accomplished at the price made, and for any purpose such reports would not be trustworthy. A good cruiser demands \$5 a day and expenses, and will not work for less. He cannot make an estimate of a section in less than four days.

If cheapness of work was to be considered a contract so large as this should certainly have been let to the lowest responsible bidder under bonds to the county for reliable work.

It is the county assessor's place to see as to the valuation of these lands, and if too low raise on them, but why under the sun he should be allowed help to the extent of \$10,000 from the county court that he might find an excuse for raising the valuation is a deeper question than an ordinary taxpayer can see through.

We believe timber assessments have been too low, and should be raised, but this could have easily been accomplished without the payment of so large a sum of money by the county for unnecessary cruising.

If the county court would commence to look out for all kinds of tax dodgers at the same rate being paid for timber cruisers it would be a very expensive job.

There is no use to raise timber valuations and give the benefit to the cruisers. Why not raise the valuation and save the money for the taxpayers?

Board of Equalization.

Notice is hereby given that on the last Monday in August, 1905, the board of equalization will meet at the office of the county clerk of Lane county, Oregon, and publicly examine the assessment rolls and correct all errors in valuation, description or qualities of lands, lots or other property, and it shall be the duty of persons interested to appear at the time and place appointed, and if it shall appear to such board of equalization that there are any lands, lots or other property assessed twice, or in the name of a person or persons not the owner thereof, or assessed under or beyond its actual value, or any lands, lots or other property not assessed said board shall make the proper corrections.

Said board of equalization shall continue its sittings from day to day, until the examination and correction of the assessment rolls, as provided by law, shall be completed.

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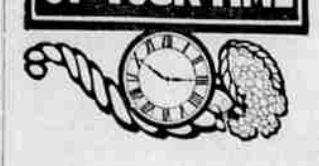
