ASSESSMENT OF DOUGLAS GREATLY INCREASED

The assessor of Douglas county has done things this year for certain. Last year the total assessment was \$5,577,925. This year it is \$18,229,175 having been made on the basis of total valuation, and it is estimated the total levy will be only 18 mills for current expenses and a deficit of \$14,000. The non-tillable land was increased \$3,051,440, to \$8,462,000, and as lots of it is owned by foreign syndicates it hits in a good place. The railroad assessment is increased from \$696,000 to \$1,974,550. Improvements on town lots and other land are non-ly trebled.
