

BRING BAKER'S REMAINS BACK TO OREGON

J. W. Geary Post, G. A. R., of this city, at its regular meeting Saturday night, passed the following resolutions:

Whereas, Colonel Edward D. Baker, an honored citizen, an eminent statesman and a gallant soldier of Oregon, was killed in battle in defense of the Union at Balls Bluff, Virginia, October 21, 1861; and

Whereas, Nearly half a century has elapsed since that tragic event and at which time he was serving the state of Oregon in the United States senate with signal ability; and

Whereas, His remains are now lying in an obscure and neglected grave in the state of California; therefore be it

Resolved, That the coming session of the legislature of Oregon be requested to pass an act providing for the removal of Colonel Baker's remains to Oregon, there to be buried, and that a suitable monument be erected to commemorate his memory and services; and be it further

Resolved, That the legislature of the state of Oregon appropriate from the general fund a sufficient amount to carry into effect the object of these resolutions; and be it further

Resolved, That a copy of these resolutions be placed in the hands of each member of the legislative delegation from Lane county and that they be urged to use every honorable means to secure the passage of a bill in conformity with the intent of these resolutions.

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PIONEER RAIL- ROAD CONDUCTOR HAS DIED

Charles Wilson, last of the pioneer railway conductors of Oregon, died at Portland Wednesday evening, after a lingering illness. He was born in New Bedford, Mass., Oct. 11, 1842, and in the early 20's came to Oregon by way of the Isthmus of Panama, settling in Portland. He had been a railroad man in the east, and when construction was well under way on the Oregon & California Railroad, on the Willamette river, Mr. Wilson became a conductor. He continued in active service for nearly thirty years. He first ran to Albany and afterwards to Roseburg, which was the end of the line for many years.

Conductor Wilson had charge of the private car of Ben Holladay on most of his trips, and he was in charge of the train which brought to Portland President Rutherford B. Hayes, general Sherman, Chief Justice White and Henry Ward Beecher.

It was under Conductor Wilson that Homer Davenport, then a most ungainly and unpromising youth, essayed to become a brakeman, but failed, and was kicked off the train by Conductor Wilson for incompetency. Mr. Davenport became Conductor Wilson's closest friend, as he considered that the former did him a lifelong service by bouncing him. When Conductor Wilson went East several years ago he was entertained in handsome manner by the famous artist.
