

WILL SHIP POTATOES AS LOCAL FREIGHT.

Robert & Dodge Determined to Get Their Stock to Market, Will Stand Additional Expense.

Robert & Dodge, of this city, announce that owing to the car shortage they are unable to move their large stock of potatoes in carload lots, but as the railroad company will accept potatoes as local shipments, they will ship them to the markets in California that way, paying the additional expense. They have at least ten carloads on hand now and will reach their destination within a few days, whereas if the firm waited for empty cars to ship them in carload lots, it might be several weeks before even the first shipment was made.

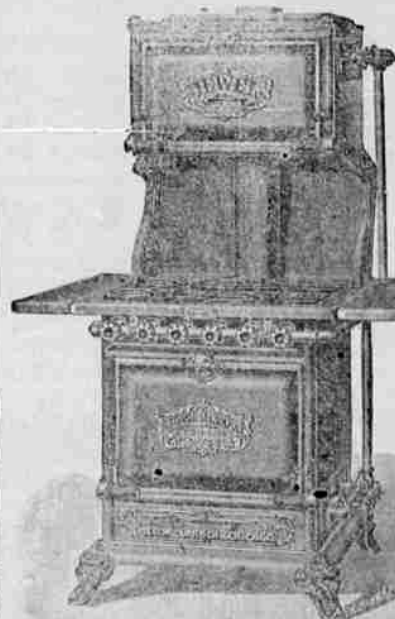
