OLD ELECTRIC LIGHT STATION PURCHASED

Charles P. and Albert F. Barnard Secure Building and Lot for \$4,000 - Will at Once Establish an Immense Woodyard on the Premises

Chas. P. Barnard, the well-known liverman of this city, and his brother, Albert F. Barnard, who handles the sawwood from the Booth-Kelly sawmill at Springfield, have purchased from D. A. Palmer, trustee of the Lane County Electric Company, which sold out to the Willamette Valley Company, the old power house on East Eighth street and the lot on which it stands for \$4,000. The lot is 164x224 feet in dimensions. The deed conveying the premises to the Barnard brothers was filed for record with the county clerk this afternoon.

The Messrs. Barnard intend to establish an immense woodyard on the premises just purchased and will at once begin the work of fixing up the buildings and erecting sheds for that purpose.
