## LIONEL STAGGE IS AGAIN IN TROUBLE

Former Oregon Convict Who Married  
Eugene Girl Is Gaining More  
Notoriety in the East - Under  
Arrest at Baltimore This Time

Lionel Stagge, the former Oregon convict who married a daughter of Colonel J. A. Straighe, formerly of Eugene, the couple afterward becoming divorced, is under arrest again, this time in Baltimore. The Oregonian's Washington correspondent writes about him as follows:

Lionel Stagge, of Portland, who says he was driven off the Pacific coast by his police record, is apparently earning high rank in the Eastern Association of Successful Bunco Artists. Three years ago Stagge was caught buncoing congressmen, and when he reappeared in Washington a month ago he was arrested on suspicion, the police being unwilling to take any chances with him, but was subsequently released on promise to leave town.

He did not travel far, for he is now under arrest at Baltimore. When the Baltimore authorities got through with him the New York courts are open to receive him. His stay in the East bids fair to be protracted.

Stagge's latest specialty is soliciting contributions from well-to-do men for "erecting a home for superannuated newspaper men." General A. L. Booth, a prominent Baltimorean, felt kindly toward this cause and contributed liberally, in addition to furnishing a fine portrait of himself to be hung in the home. Stagge also touched up Nicholas Markey, of Baltimore, whom he met in London. To Mr. Markey, during their friendly days, Stagge exhibited a check for \$12,000, which he said was in settlement of his mother's estate.

In New York Stagge associated with none but fullbloods, and was able to demonstrate that John D. Rockefeller, Andrew Carnegie and J. Pierpont Morgan were not yet too wise to be gold-bricked. He worked two games among financiers, the newspaper home racket and the biographical that is as old as the hills.

Stagge is understood to have married an actress, who has proven of great success in keeping him out of the clutches of the New York police.

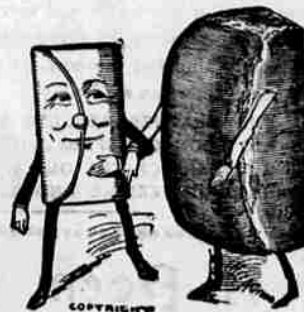
