

BEZDEK RETURNS FROM HIS TRIP TO THE EAST

Physical Director at University Back to Work Again - Would Have Been Back Sooner but for Unavoidable Delays - Will Begin Work on Basketball Team

Coach Hugo Bezdek arrived in Eugene from his trip to Chicago on this morning's early train and is ready to take up his duties again at the university as physical director. He says he had a very good time back East and would have come back sooner but for unavoidable delays.

Bezdek began work this afternoon again with the basketball team. He thinks that there is good material that will develop very rapidly in the time at his disposal. While East he also made arrangements so that he can get all of the sporting goods of the university, that cannot be obtained here, quickly and easily from San Francisco. Bezdek will also coach the baseball team this spring.

New Bulletin.
The December Bulletin of the university has been issued and is now ready for distribution to the public. The book deals with the libraries of the universities of the different states of the Union. From back to back it shows great care and discrimination. Professor Schafer superintended the gathering of the materials, while a number of the faculty contributed short articles on the books in their departments.

Gold Footballs.
The executive committee of the student body of the university met yesterday afternoon and appropriated \$50, which was estimated would be the deficit, for oratory and debate. The recommendation of the athletic council that gold footballs should be given to the graduating members of the football team of 1906 was also passed. The men who will receive footballs are Captain Chandler, Hug, McKinney and Latourette.

Broad Tests for Scholarships.
Competition between the five young men who are trying for the Rhodes scholarship is said to be very keen, and as the tests are very cosmopolitan, touching the candidates on every side, the interest is very great. The candidates are tried out by the following process: Two points out of ten are taken from the record for scholarship of the candidate, two from the special examinations, two from the athletic ability, two from the place held in student body affairs, and two from general culture and accomplishments, as debate, oratory, etc.
