

HITCHCOCK'S

RULING PUT
TO ONE SIDE

Washington, Feb. 15.—The president has practically revoked Secretary Hitchcock's order suspending all public land entries until they can be examined by special agents. Homestead and timber entries may now pass to patent when the entrymen have complied with the law and submitted proof thereof, and examination is unnecessary.

The modification follows suggestions made by Senator Fulton, and entirely removes the objections that have been made by the timber entrymen in Oregon. In the following classes no examination by a special agent is required:

1. Final five-year homestead entry hereafter made, where proof is satisfactory and complete.
2. Final certificates and receipts in final five-year homestead proofs heretofore or hereafter made, when proof is satisfactory and complete.
3. Homestead entries commuted on ceded inland lands on which annual payments are required.
4. Entries where the claimants' compliance with the law has been established by contest or other regular adverse proceedings.
5. Entries confirmed which may have been confirmed by virtue of any act of congress.
6. Selections and entries in which no residence or improvement is required by law when land embraced therein is located in non-mineral localities as shown by records of the geological survey, when the character has been fixed by investigation and classification made in accordance with law.
7. Reissuance of patents because of some clerical error occurring in patents heretofore issued.
8. Military bounty land warrants and other similar warrants when request for proof has been made.

Where timber lands are situated in "mineral localities" referred to in section 6, there may be some possibility of delay; examination might have to be made.

JACK RABBITS ARE AFFLICTED WITH TUBERCULOSIS

Dr. J. T. Lloyd, veterinarian of Baker City, has recently made investigation of the disease which is prevalent among the black-tailed rabbits found so plentiful in that section of Oregon and especially in the west end of Umatilla county, and he says that these animals are suffering from tuberculosis of a pronounced type.

The tuberculosis germ is found in their lungs in large quantities and in his opinion this is one of the most serious menaces to the health of the county which exist.

The rabbits are found in all stages of the disease, many of them perishing from it. He believes that it is a matter which concerns the public and that some steps should be taken to eradicate them by state law, in the interest of the public health.

It is possible for the rabbits to transmit the germs to dogs, which eat the carcasses, to cattle, sheep and other domestic animals and in his opinion there is no limit to the harmful possibilities that lie in this state of affairs.—Baker City Democrat.
