CRAZED BY LIQUOR.

GARRETT SHOTS THREE

Portland, Or., March 14.--Crazed by over-indulgence in strong drink, brooding over fancied or real grievances, and consumed by an uncontrollable lust for blood, Peter Garrett, 23 years of age, formerly an employe of the Multnomah box factory, started out last night on a campaign of murder, with the result that Anton Grohs, proprietor of a saloon at 315 Water street, and James Higley, of 767 Macadam road, lie mortally wounded at the Good Samaritan hospital, while John Gavin, residing at the foot of Clay street, is nursing a serious bullet wound in the left shoulder.

The shooting occurred in front of Grohs' saloon, at 7:30 p. m., and three and one-half hours later the youthful desperado was apprehended after exciting circumstances on North Third street by Sergeant Baly and Detective John F. Price.

Carried Loaded Pistols.

When arrested Garrett was found in possession of two loaded pistols, and it was only by prompt action of the officers in disarming him that the youth was prevented from adding other victims to his list.

Activity in Hops.

There has been a greater activity among the hopmen during the past few days than there has been for some time, and while the prices have not materially advanced, the indications are that the increased demand will have its effect in that direction. According to a report from the Dallas section there has been a greater number of buyers asking for hops, but the growers have refused to consider 10 and 11 cents. Many sections report a similar condition. Several firms are said to be offering 12 and 12 1/2 cents and considerable lots are being sold, but a few more lots are being held.
