MAHON SUES FOR \$40,000 COMMISSION

Seeks to Recover That Amount From M. B. Rankin, the Portland Capitalist, Who Purchased Large Tract of Timber Land in Lane County - Suit Filed in Portland Today

Portland March 19.—H. C. Mahon, the Eugene timber broker, today instituted suit in the circuit court against M. B. Rankin, a well-known capitalist, for the recovery of \$40,000, alleged due as commission on the tracts recently bought by Rankin through Mahon in the Willamette country, in Lane county. Mahon also asks for interest on that amount from January 15, 1907, at 6 per cent. Judge M. L. Pipes, of Portland, and G. F. Shipworth, of Eugene, are his attorneys.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Bids Will Be Received for Paving Willamette Street.

Notice is hereby given that the common council of the city of Eugene will receive bids for the construction of the improvement of Willamette street, from the south line of the Southern Pacific Company's right-of-way to the south line of Eleventh street, provided for under ordinance number 661, passed by the common council March 11, 1907, and approved by the mayor on March 11, 1907.

Said improvement to consist of the excavation of said street as provided for by the plans and specifications prepared therefor by the city engineer; the construction of uniform cement curbing in and along either side of said street between said points, to be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications prepared therefor by the city engineer, and for the pavement of said street between said points with bituminous pavement, said pavement to be in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared therefor by the city engineer, all of which plans and specifications are now on file in the office of the city recorder.

Bids for said improvement will be received by the common council at the office of the city recorder up to 7:30 o'clock p. m. on Tuesday, the 26th day of March, 1907, at which time said bids will be opened and considered by the common council.

Each of the above specified improvements are to be let by separate contract to the lowest responsible bidder therefor, the common council reserving the right to reject any or all bids.

A certified check for five per cent of the amount bid shall accompany each bid or proposal.

The excavation, as provided by the plans and specifications, shall be completed within 70 days from letting of the contract therefor; the curbing provided for shall be completed within 70 days from the letting of the contract therefor, and the paving shall be completed within 90 days from the date of letting of the contract therefor.

Attention of all contractors is called to the agreement of Warren Brothers Company, filed with this city, in accordance with which agreement Warren Brothers Company agrees to license all contractors desiring to bid for the work to lay the bituminous pavement in accordance with its patents and the terms of said agreement.
