OREGON SHEEP MUST BE DIPPED THIS YEAR

Many people are not yet aware of the fact that under the new law in this state all sheep must be dipped annually, whether they are diseased or not. The authorized stock inspector in this county is Dr. J. Christie.

Following is a full synopsis of the rules and regulations adopted by the state board of sheep commissioners, and are now in force.

The inspectors of the bureau of animal industry of the United States, having been appointed special deputy state sheep inspectors of the state of Oregon by the state sheep inspector, while acting as such special deputy state sheep inspectors, are hereby empowered and directed to go to any county or locality in the state of Oregon and there perform the duties of deputy state sheep inspector or any of his other deputies in such county or locality.

The state board of sheep commissioners of Oregon hereby gives its consent and indicates its willingness that the bureau of animal industry of the United States and its employees shall come within the state of Oregon for all purposes connected with the exportation of diseased sheep and for the extermination of infectious and contagious diseases among sheep.

WATER POWER FOR OPERATION OF SAWMILL

H. H. Fisk, of Mapleton, through his attorney, J. M. Pipes, today filed with the county clerk a notice of appropriation of the waters of Had-sall creek, a tributary of the Sals-law river, for the purpose of generating power for the operation of a sawmill. The notice calls for 6000 inches of water, miners' measure, under a six-inch pressure, and the point of diversion is about the center of the northeast corner of the northeast quarter of section 14, township 18 south of range 10 west. The flume is to be eight feet wide, five feet deep and 1500 feet in length. There are to be three reservoirs, one at the point of diversion and the other two between there and the outlet of the flume.

Nothing is known of Mr. Fisk's plans concerning the erection of a sawmill at that place. His brother, Sheriff Fred Fisk, today stated that it was the intention to build the plant some time in the future, but the plans are not yet far enough along to give full publicity to them. The Messrs. Fisk have been purchasing a large amount of timber land on the Salslaw river during the past year or two and are said to be among the heaviest holders in that part of the county.

The location of the site of the proposed water power plant is a few miles below Mapleton.

The other vacancies to be filled are that of city superintendent, principal of the high school and a teacher in the high school.
